THE CLUB MEETING

Our Club meeting is split into 3 parts.

PREPARED SPEECHES: In this segment, club members prepare and deliver 5 to 7 minute speeches derived from the Pathways Education Program. Delivering speeches counts as credits towards the Education program.





- 2 IMPROMPTU SPEECHES: In this segment, club members and guests attempt speaking off-the-cuff on any topic that is presented by the "Table Topics Master".

 Speeches are for 1 to 2 minutes.
 Impromptu speaking improves our critical thinking skills.
- FEEDBACK: This is the critical part of any Toastmaster meeting.
 Speakers and role players are provided feedback on how well they performed, and offer areas of improvement. Continuous feedback and learning is the heart of the Toastmaster journey.



PATHWAYS EDUCATION PROGRAM

The Pathways learning experience is Toastmasters' education program. This multi-language online learning tool allows you to leverage over 300 practical workplace skills, including:
